Application fee: \$25. Application deadline: Wednesday, Feb. 21, 2018. Please make check payable to Swedish Club, enclose with this form, and mail to the address below. The fee is nonrefundable after acceptance to the sale.

Space is limited. Spaces will be assigned by event coordinator. Set up in designated space only. Electricity will be provided, but you must provide your own electrical power strips and cords, in compliance with Washington State Fire and Safety Code. Tables will be provided by the Swedish Club, but please provide and use your own table skirts. You may have up to two tables, unless you bring your own. Your area will not have a wall for affixing signs or items for sale. You are responsible to set up and maintain your display so that no threat or nuisance is made to the public. We encourage you to set up on Friday, Mar. 2, when the building will be open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. You may unload your sale items from the parking lot on the south side of the building. **However, please park on the street and save parking spaces for customers.** If you need assistance or handicapped parking, let us know.

Please note that 10% of gross sales (less the application fee of \$25) will be due at the end of the event to the Swedish Club in the form of a check, or, if paying with cash, rounded to the nearest dollar. The Center and anyone working on the sale will take every reasonable precaution to avoid loss, damage or theft to items for sale at the Antiques & Great Finds Sale. The building is locked except during the sale. However, we assume no responsibility in the event of loss, damage, theft or injury to anyone participating in the event. Vendors are responsible for dismantling or covering their displays after hours and collecting money for sales. Vendors who dismantle their displays and/or leave prior to 3 p.m. will be charged an additional fee of \$25. We ask each vendor to donate one item to the Swedish Club to be used in our raffle that day. On the raffle table, the item will be identified as being a donation from the vendor.
