No photos, please.

CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

- ✓ Must be a high school senior, attend a high school in King County, and reside in King County, Washington.
- ✓ Must submit completed application, transcript, ACT or SAT score, information about family income, and a **self-addressed, stamped envelope in order to receive notification of results.**
- ✓ Finalists must be available for a personal interview.

Note: Swedish ancestry not required.

Finalists will be selected on the following basis:

- a) The candidate's high school record.
- b) ACT or SAT score.
- c) Financial assessment.
- d) Leadership and community service.

Finalists will be selected by May 1, 2019, and notified as soon as possible. **Finalists must be available for a personal interview**, which will take place on Saturday, May 18, 2019. Awards will be granted for fall quarter/semester 2019 and will be paid directly to the college/university.

Application materials will not be returned. All records will be destroyed after selection process is completed.
